

Who Are We:

Hope Attachment Training and Therapeutic Services Ltd has been supporting families in Sheffield for five years. We are a holistic service, so as part of our support to families, we also offer consultation and training to schools and other professionals around the family. We are commissioned by Adoption Support (through the Adoption Support Fund) for therapeutic work with families and commissioned by schools for consultation and training to support staff.

Meet the Trainer:

Fiona Sheikh, Founder and Director of Hope Attachment was first introduced to children in the case system when she was a teenager and her parents fostered teens.

This knowledge was deepened during the 5 years she and her husband were foster carers for Sheffield City Council.

She also has 10 years' experience of supporting schools and families affected by risks to their emotional wellbeing. This has been both as Therapeutic Attachment Specialist providing attachment based therapeutic support to children and their families and in her role as trainer/consultant in her support to schools nationally, as well as speaking at conferences across the UK.

Fiona has undertaken training in Theraplay Level 1 and 2, Dyadic Developmental Psychotherapy (DDP) Level 1 and 2, Family Futures Neurophysiological Psychotherapy (NPP) Level 1 and 2 as well as a BSc (Honours) in Psychology and is partly completed her Masters in Attachment Studies at Roehampton University. She has also undertaken Éadaoin Bhreathnach's Just Right State Children's Programme and Parents Programme.

The trainings will draw on her experience and relate theory to real life behaviours, seen at home and in school, and share tools and strategies and understanding in an empathetic and interesting way.

TRAINING ONE:

Exploring the Risks to Emotional Wellbeing in Children and Young People and the effect on Children's Attachment Strategies and Brain Development

Part One of this training will open attendees' minds to the different experiences that impact on children and young people emotional well-being. It will explore latest research on Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) as well as other risks eg parents who are too protective or too interested in their own agendas.

Part Two of this training will help attendees gain knowledge on Bowlby and Ainsworth's attachment theory but will also take attendees into a deeper understanding of symptoms of attachment strategies being displayed in children's behaviour through exploration of the Dynamic Maturational Model or Attachment suggested by Crittenden.

Part Three of this training will help us understand how early life relationships shape our brain and our understanding of relationships, ourselves, and the world.

The training will call on latest theory, real life examples and case studies from Fiona's experiences and give tools through checklists to help attendees understand the children in their care and key strategies to help with difficulties being shown.

Course Objectives:

This in-depth training will increase your knowledge of:

- The impact of different risk factors to children's emotional wellbeing.
- Research around Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs).
- Up to date research and understanding of attachment theory.
- Up to date research on brain development and it's links to attachment
- Key strategies for working with children who have been or are at risk to their emotional wellbeing

What Will You Take Away from This Training?

- Skills to be able to identify risks to the emotional wellbeing of children in your care or who you work with
- Attachment strategies of children in your care or who you work with
- How early life experiences will have impacted on the brain development of the children in your care or who you work with
- Key attachment-based strategies to help children in your care or who you work with

Parents, carers, school staff and other professionals who care for or work with children who have faced or may face risks to their emotional wellbeing eg looked after or adopted children, children in domestic abuse situations, children living in less than ideal circumstances or children who have insensitive caregivers.

An Introduction to Emotional Regulation Difficulties in Children and Young People

Overview: Many children find emotional regulation difficult and either overreact and dysregulate with big emotions or shut down and freeze. This includes children impacted by ACEs/trauma, ADHD, Autism, or anxiety. This training will explore emotional regulation from a trauma perspective, where children have had insensitive caregivers in the early years and look at the impact on their emotional regulation development. Tried and tested methods to help children learn regulation skills, with the help of an external regulator ie key adult will be shared (which are also helpful for children with ADHD and Autism and anxiety too).

Course Objectives:

This in-depth training will increase your knowledge of:

- The foundation of emotional regulation skills.
- Why children react the way they do when emotionally dysregulated.
- Different ways to help children become more emotionally regulated.

What Will You Take Away from This Training?

- An understanding of emotional regulation difficulties to enable you to understand children you work or care for.
- Key strategies and activities to help children start to learn to be more emotionally regulated.

Who should attend this training:

Parents, carers, school staff and other professionals who care for or work with children who have difficulty in being emotionally regulated.

An Introduction to Executive Functioning and Sensory Integration Difficulties in Children and Young People at Home

Overview: Often parents and carers struggle with children who are too loud, get easily distracted, don't understand how their behaviour affects other, find noises or smells upsetting. Sometimes parent and carers see behaviours they're not sure where they are coming from. The root of these could be underlying executive functioning and sensory integration difficulties which are neurological difficulties that can't be changed but we can help children and young people learn about their own needs and have strategies to help them to function more successfully day to day.

Course Objectives:

This in-depth training will increase your knowledge of:

- What are executive functioning difficulties and how do they manifest at home.
- What are sensory integration difficulties and how do they manifest at home.
- Strategies to help you to support you child/ren to become successful at home.

What Will You Take Away from This Training?

- The ability to understand which are of executive functioning or sensory integration difficulties your child/ren may be struggling with.
- Tools to help spot these difficulties.
- Key strategies to support your child/ren with these difficulties.

Who should attend this training:

Parents and carers of professionals who support families.

An Introduction to Executive Functioning and Sensory Integration Difficulties in Children and Young People in the Classroom

Overview: Over the years of supporting schools with children who struggle in the classroom, we have identified many who have executive functioning and/or sensory integration difficulties. These difficulties often present as "behavioural difficulties" ie procrastinating over work, not getting along with peers, being too rough with others, not understanding cause and effect but in fact stem from executive functioning and sensory integration difficulties which are neurological difficulties that can't be changed but we can help children and young people learn about their own needs and strategies to help them become more successful in the classroom.

Course Objectives:

This in-depth training will increase your knowledge of:

- What are executive functioning difficulties and how do they manifest in the classroom.
- What are sensory integration difficulties and how do they manifest in the classroom.
- Strategies to help children and young people become successful in the classroom.

What Will You Take Away from This Training?

- The ability to understand which children in the classroom may be struggling with executive functioning or sensory integration difficulties.
- Tools to help spot these difficulties.
- Key strategies to support students in school with these difficulties.

Who should attend this training:

School staff and other professionals who support children in the classroom.

Overview:

Having been supporting families for 10 years and doing lots of training and research, I have amalgamated the top tips or evidence-based interventions to help you parent/care for a child who has a traumatic start to life.

We have been running in depth therapeutic training for the last 4 years, and this short course will call on the key thoughts, theories, and strategies to help you support your child/ren at home. The training calls on all the latest research from the likes of Dan Hughes, Dan Siegel, Brian Post, Theraplay and Non-Violence Resistance Programme.
